BASIC REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA) and Licensed in the state of Louisiana by the LBAB.
- Maintain credentials and remain in good standing with BCBA and LBAB.
- Must have earned a Mastered Degree in a related field.
- Must pass a background check.
- Must be proficient in video conferencing.
- Must have a BLS (Basic Life Support) certification.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES:

- Provide virtual Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) therapy.
- Supervise RBT/RLTs and BCaBAs.
- Conduct VB-MAPP, ABLLS-R, ALFS, or other curriculum assessments
- Conducts Functional Assessments of Behavior (FAB)
- Develops Behavior Intervention Plans (BIPs)
- Assist RBT/RLTs/BCaBAs, teach skills, monitor implementation of treatment
- Develop and implement positive behavior plans and strategies.
- Oversee assessments, plan development, and ongoing program data analysis to ensure maximum client progress.
- Manage and update client plans.
- Assist with daily changes and updates to schedule as children and/or staff are out due to illness, vacation, etc
- Conducts parent and caregiver training sessions.
- Ensure accurate data collection procedures, skill acquisition, and behavior reduction.
- Provides ongoing assessments, monitor progress and make necessary changes to treatment plan.
